CEO REPORT

Jane Rozanski, Chief Executive Officer, reported on the overwhelming success of the "Aging Successfully" lecture held at the District in partnership with the Notre Dame Club of Ventura County, and the Hesburgh Lecture Series. Ms. Rozanski also reported that the District, for the 5th consecutive year, has been named a "2009 Ventura County Family Friendly Employer," in addition, receiving the Ventura County Small Business Award.
